Secure devices

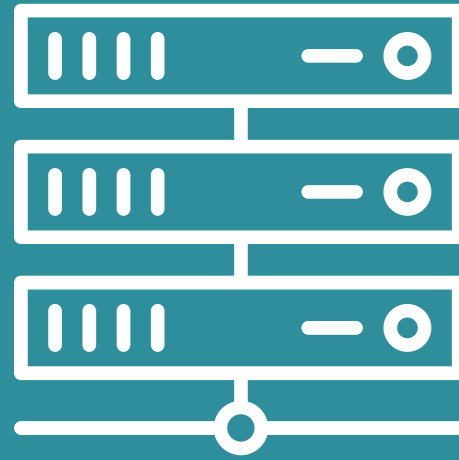
Ensure that all devices, including laptops, phones, and tablets, are updated with the latest software and security patches.
