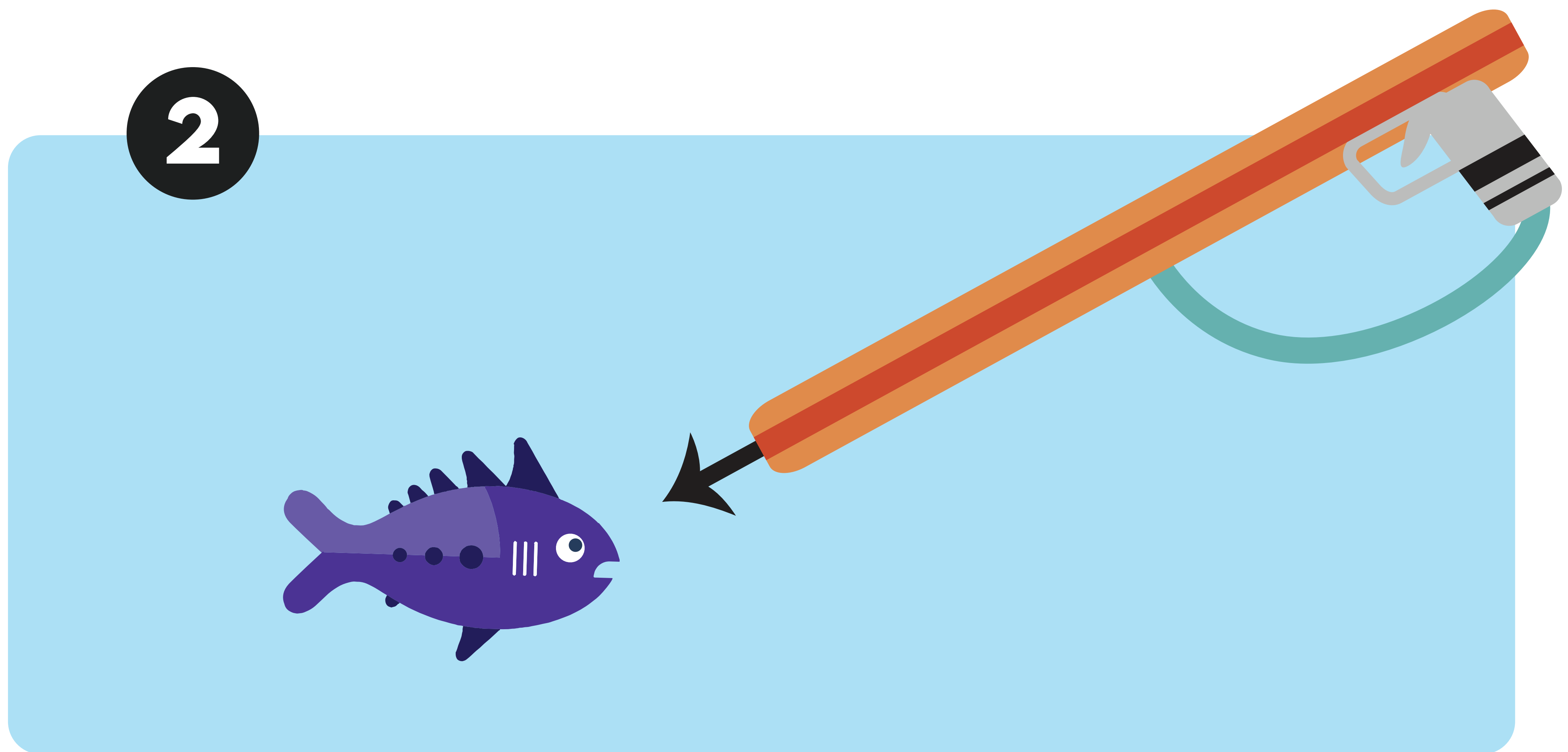

PHISHING



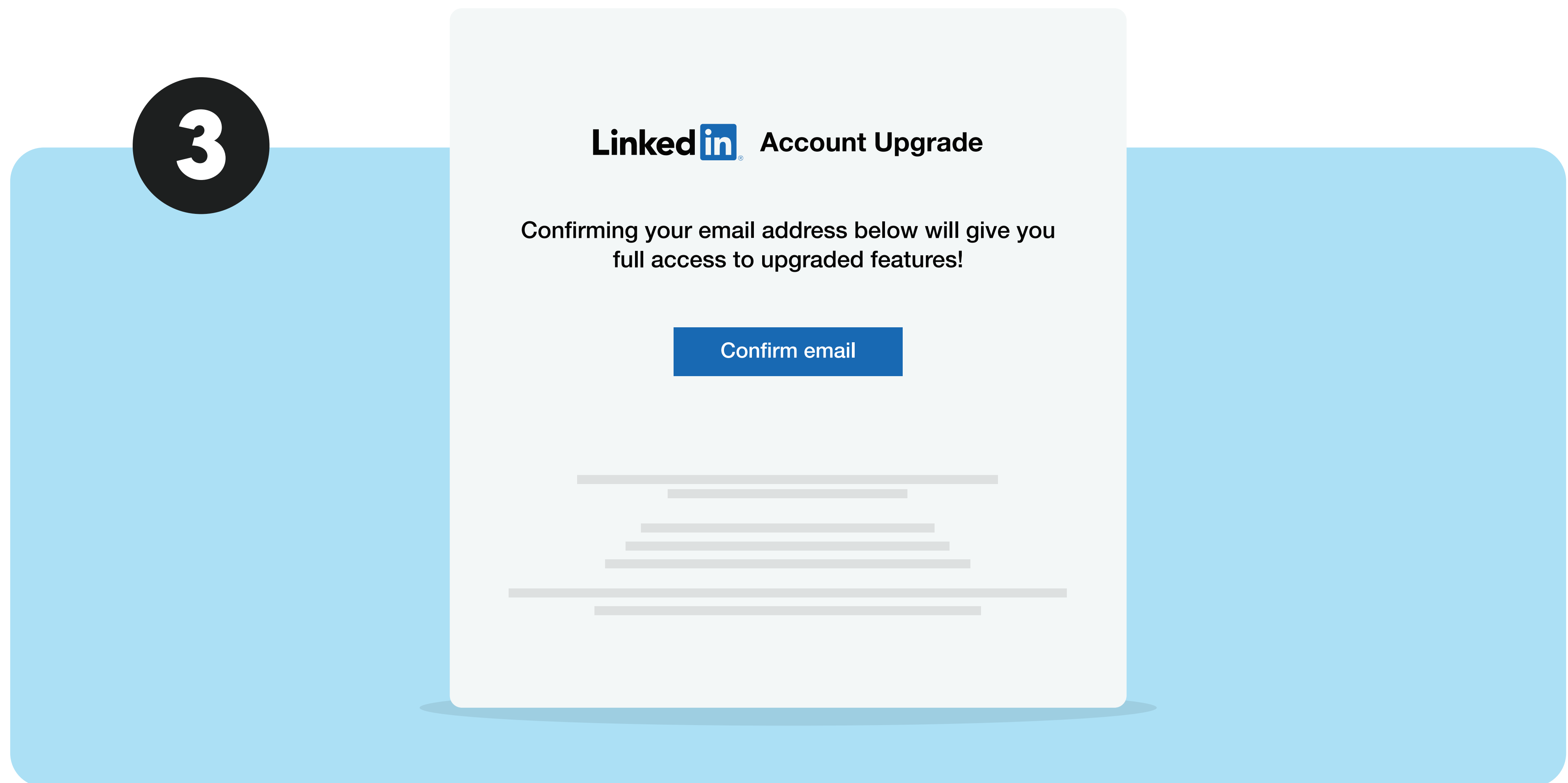
EMAIL PHISHING

Scammers create emails that impersonate legitimate companies and attempt to steal your information.



SPEARPHISHING

Similar to email phishing, but the messages are more targeted. For example, they may appear to come from your boss.



CLONE PHISHING

A clone phishing attack uses a legitimate or previously sent email that contains attachments or links.



WHALING

Scammers target high-ranking executives to gain access to sensitive data or money.



POP-UP PHISHING

Fraudulent pop-ups trick users into installing malware.
